<u>R Visa Checklist</u>

Passport	Original passport with at least one blank visa page and valid for at least 6 months.
Passport copy	One photocopy of data and photo pages of passport.
Application Form	One completely filled Visa Application Form(V. 2013). Please fill in with the free Adobe Acrobat Reader.
Photo	One photo which must meet the <u>specific requirements</u> .
Proof of legal status of non-Australian	Non-Australian applicant should have legal status in Australia and a copy of current status proof, such as <u>VEVO</u> , <u>ImmiCard</u> or visa should be submitted.
<i>Previous Chinese passports or Chinese visa</i>	When applying for Chinese visa with a new passport, applicant who used to be of Chinese citizenship should submit the original and a copy of the data page of the last Chinese passport, or a copy of previous Chinese visa on the previous foreign passport. If your name on the current passport differs from that on the previous passport, an official document of name change should also be submitted.
<i>Relevant Certificate</i>	The applicant should submit relevant certification in accordance with relevant regulations, and meet the relevant requirements of the competent authorities of the Chinese government on high-level talents and individuals with special skills urgently needed by China.
