	<i>Previous Chinese passport or Chinese visa</i>	When applying for Chinese visa with a new passport, applicant who used to be of Chinese citizenship should
		submit the original and a copy of data page of the last Chinese passport, or a copy of previous Chinese visa on the
		previous foreign passport.
		If the name on the current passport differs from that on the previous passport, an official document of name
		change should also be submitted.
	<i>Relevant certificate</i>	The applicant should submit relevant certification in accordance with relevant regulations, and meet the relevant
		requirements of the competent authorities of the Chinese government on high-level talents and individuals with
		special skills urgently needed by China.
